RE: Extension of time to seek recovery as a result of damages sustained in Hurricane Katrina and/or Rita from one year to two years

Many insurance policies issued by LA Citizens require you to settle your claim or file a lawsuit within one year from the date of loss to extend your recovery period.

(1) Because many Hurricane Katrina and Rita claims are not yet resolved, the LA Citizens Board of Directors has voted to extend from one to two years the time period in which a LA Citizens policyholder can seek recovery as a result of their hurricane-related claim.

(2) For policyholders with a Hurricane Katrina claim, the final date in which to file a lawsuit as a result of that claim has been extended to August 29, 2007, which is two years from the date of loss. For policyholders with a Hurricane Rita claim, the final date has been extended to September 24, 2007.

This change gives you more time to conclude your Hurricane Katrina and/or Rita claim and **does not change or waive any other provision of your policy.**
