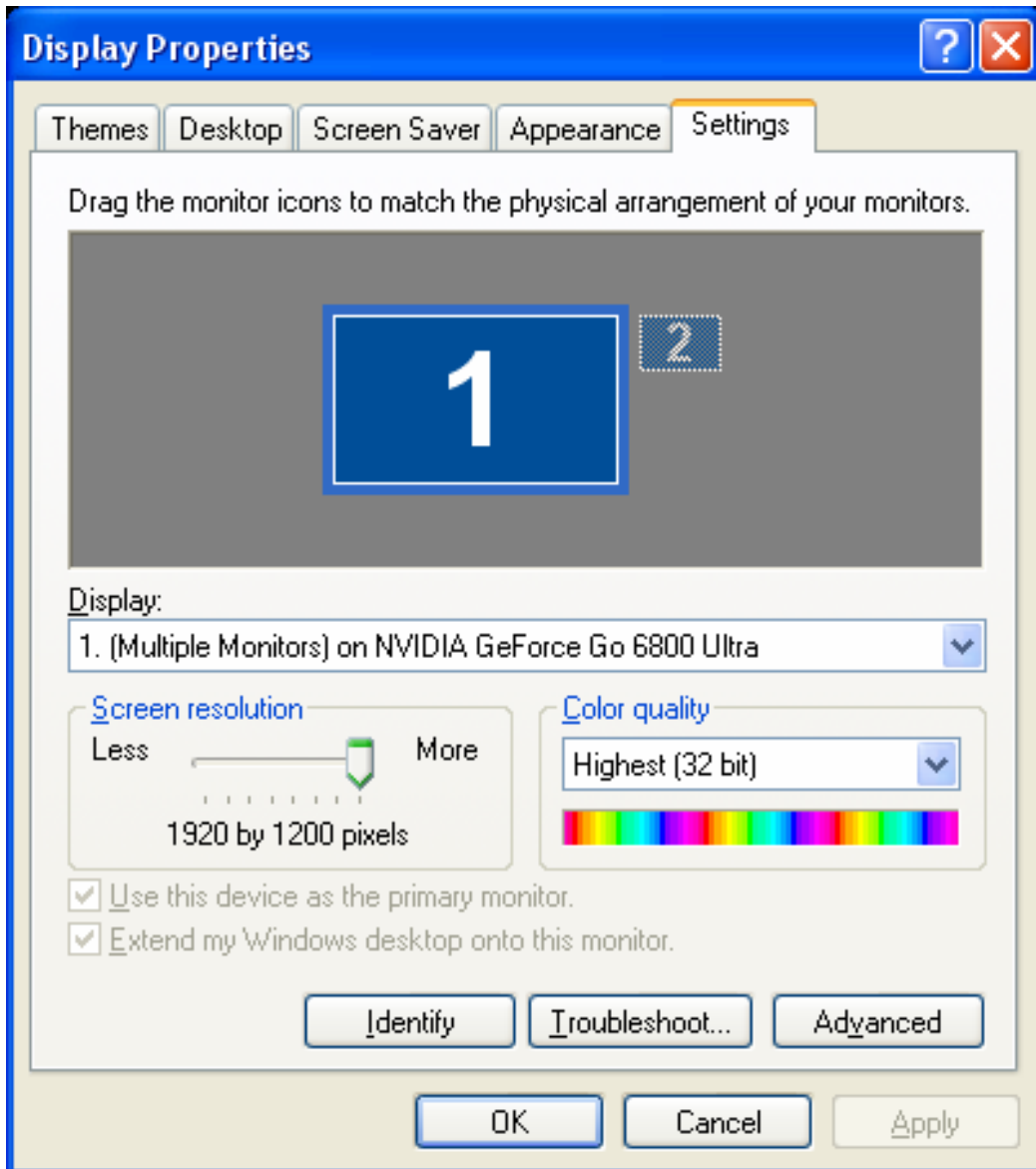


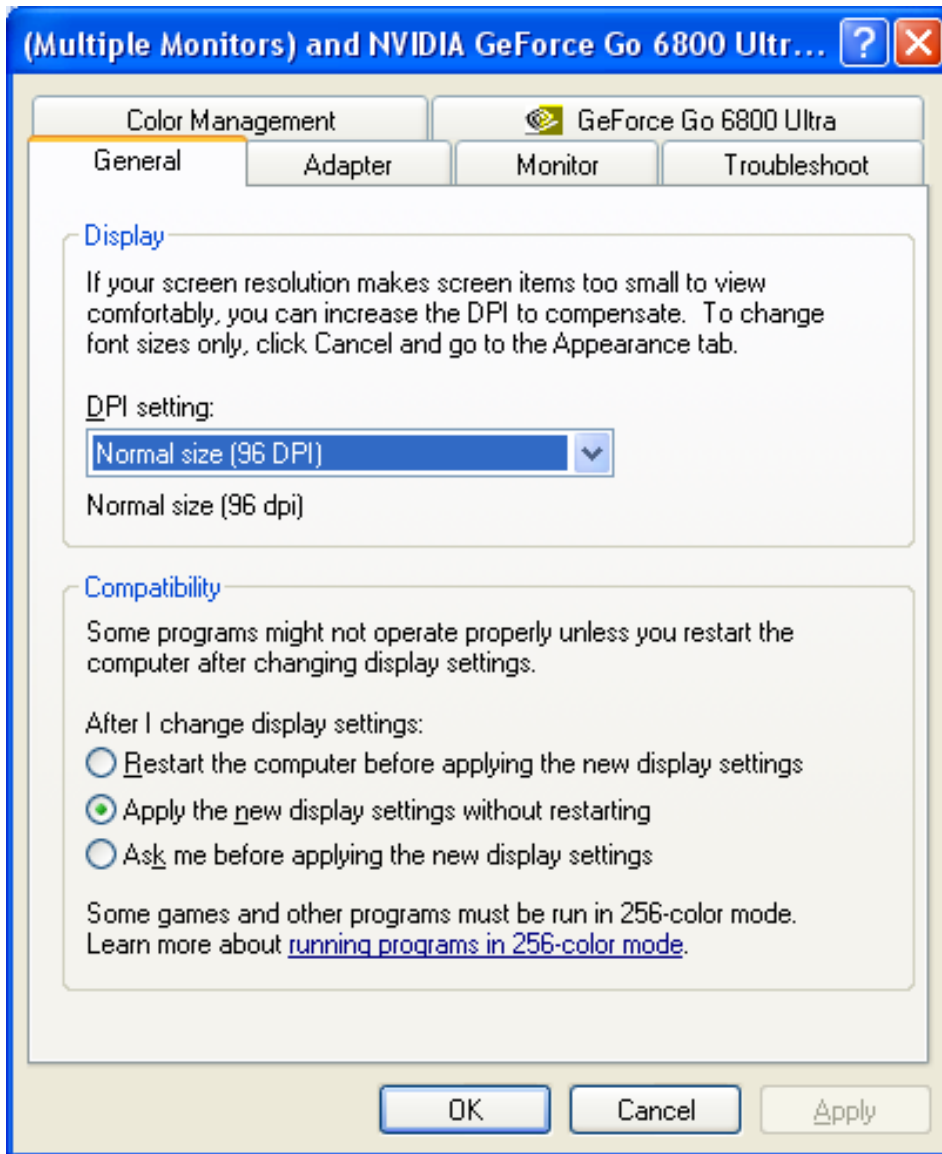
Setting the DPI Font property to Normal in order to Prevent Jumbled Text in a Web Browser

Right click on an empty area of the *desktop* and go down to **properties** to bring up the **Display Properties** Box.



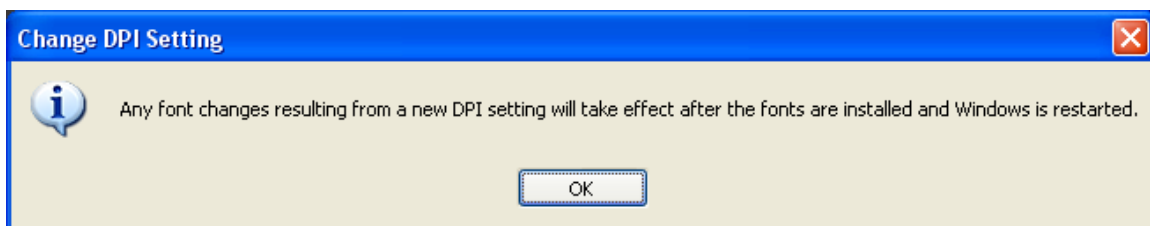
Click on the **Settings** Tab.

Click on the **Advanced** Button.

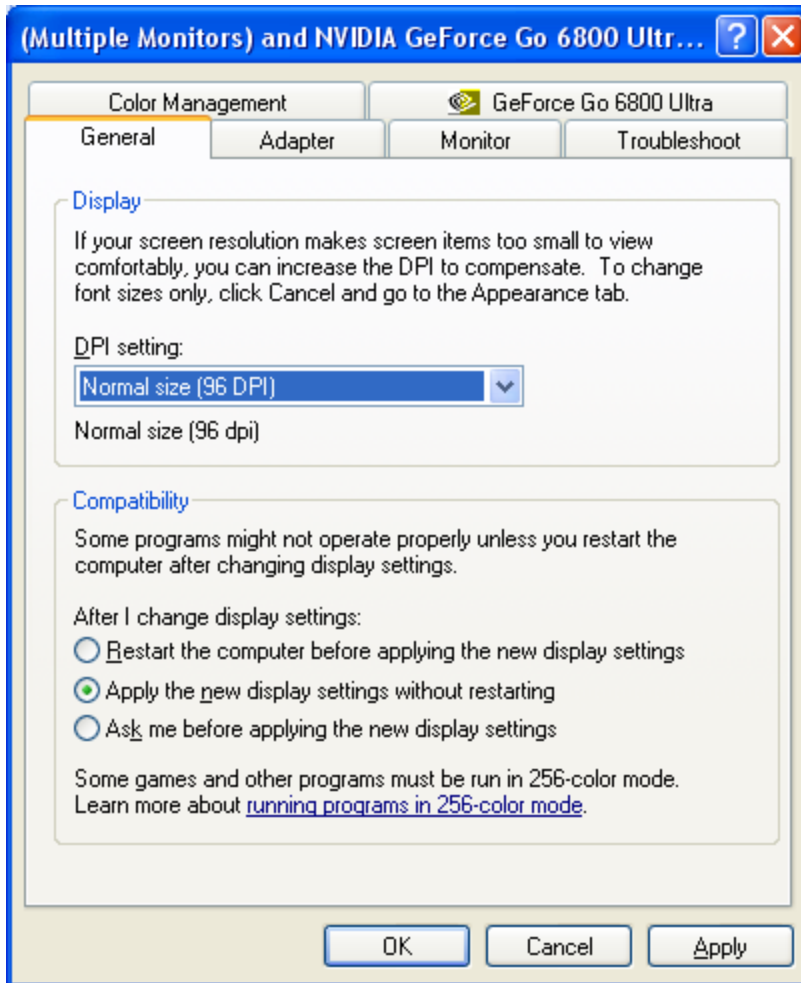


Make sure that the **DPI** setting is set to *Normal* or **96 DPI** and click the **OK** Button

If you have changed the setting from **120** (*large*) to **96** (*normal*), a message will appear after you clicked **OK**.

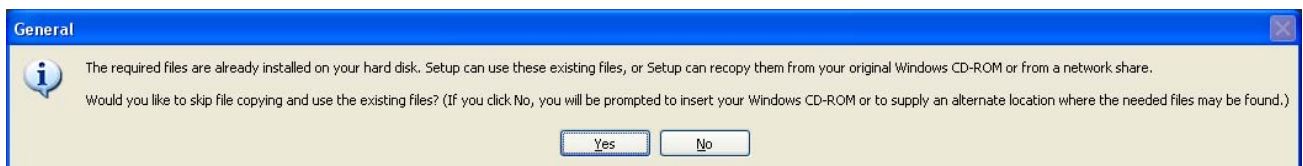


Click **OK**.



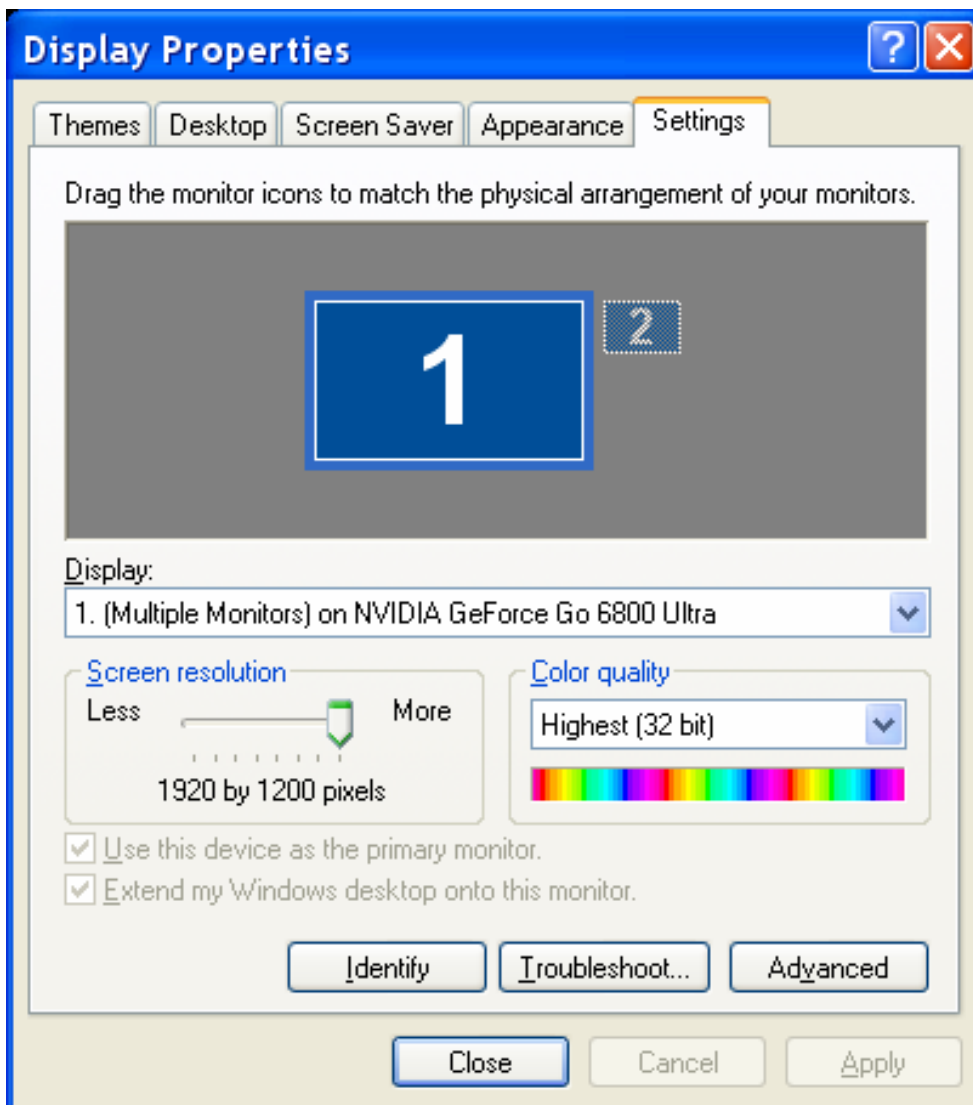
Click **OK** on the bottom of the above screen.

After clicking OK another message box will pop-up that says: “*The required files are already installed on your hard disk. Setup can use...*” etc.

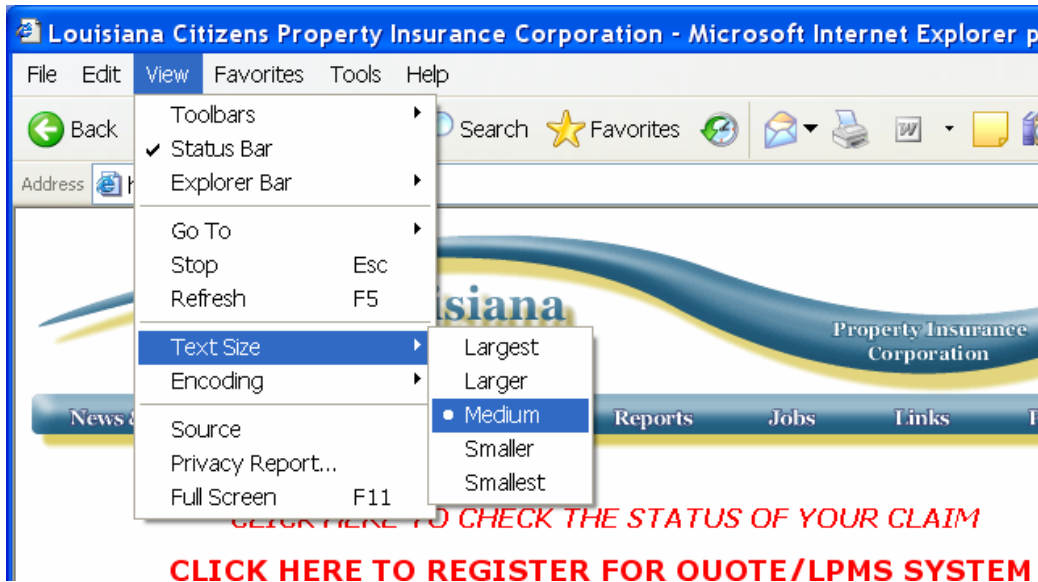


Click the **OK** Button.

The **Display Properties** Box will be *active* again.
Click the **Close** button.



Open your **Internet Explorer** Web browser.



Make sure the Text Size is set to medium by going to View→Text Size→ and selecting Medium.

Go back to the web site.
